



ARCHIVAL ENQUIRIES GOVERNING RULES and PRICE LIST

1. PUMST is open to all persons interested in the history of the Polish Underground State 1939 -1945 and the Home Army (AK)
2. As far as possible PUMST Staff will provide assistance in searching for information by person visiting PUMST free of charge
3. PUMST also answer enquiries by telephone, letter and email
4. It may take 4-6 weeks to answer an archival enquiry received by telephone, letter or email
5. To cover in part costs of running PUMST the following charges are applicable:

General Archival Enquiry: £10.00 per hour of work by PUSMT Staff

- The above price covers the searching for information on one specific subject
- The above price does not cover costs of photocopying, reproduction, postage and copyright fees
- Here is a minimum £10 fee regardless of the result of the search (regardless whether information is found or not)
- PUMST does not guarantee a possible result of any search undertaken. Every interested party will be informed prior to the research being started about the likelihood of finding documentation for the topic researched and the estimated cost of the research

Family Enquiry: £15.00 per person researched

- The above fee covers the research involved to find documents directly relating to the person being researched (verification documents, personal certificates, written depositions etc.)
- The above fee is applicable only if there is a positive result
- The above fee does not include additional costs of photocopying, reproduction, postage and copyright fees
- The interested party will be informed of any additional costs prior to the work being carried out
- PUMST reserves the right to refuse access to materials containing personal information of the person researched
